This includes disassembling the lift truck, rebuilding the engine, sandblasting the lift and after that reassembling the whole thing and finishing with a fresh coat of paint.

To thoroughly rebuild a forklift engine, a good company will firstly absolutely disassemble it. A heat cleaning system is then utilized to clean all of the parts. As soon as this step has been completed, all of the parts are checked to see if they have any breakage, any extensive wear or any defects. Particular parts such as cylinder heads, crankshafts, cylinder blocks and connecting rods are reground, resurfaced and resized if considered necessary. Other parts such as gears, nuts, bolts and so forth. are replaced or repaired as considered necessary.

The engine is rebuilt by hand when the overhaul has been completed. After putting it back together, a series of tests are applied to the working equipment. This is done so as to check all of the components to ensure there are no problems or leaks. If any problems occur, the necessary adjustments are made.
